



Organically and biodynamically grown in the heart of Muscadet, the 2024 "Les Bonnets Blancs" is crisp, coastal, and full of energy. Bursting with citrus, green apple, and a saline edge, it's a vibrant, mineral white wine perfect for oysters, sunshine, and refreshing, everyday elegance.
