**Loire: Muscadet- Bonnet Huteau**  
**Les Bonnets Blanc 2024**  
**Muscadet**

Organically and biodynamically grown in the heart of Muscadet, the 2024 "Les Bonnets Blancs" is crisp, coastal, and full of energy. Bursting with citrus, green apple, and a saline edge, it's a vibrant, mineral white wine perfect for oysters, sunshine, and refreshing, everyday elegance.

**Loire: Saumur- Domaine de l'Enchantoir**  
**"Terres Blanches"**  
**Chenin Blanc**

Aged on fine lees, Terres Blanches reveals pure brightness and chiselled minerality. Drawn from Turonian limestone and clay on the slopes of Puy-Notre-Dame, this Chenin Blanc captures Saumur's cool, white-stone elegance—citrus, pear, quince and a whisper of honey. Perfect with oysters, grilled fish, or goat cheese, it finishes long, saline, and vibrant.

**Fiano di Avellino**

From Colli di Lapio, this flagship Fiano di Avellino is highly rated for its precision: white peach, pear and citrus blossom, with hazelnut and flinty minerality. Creamy yet vibrant, it carries acidity into a long, saline finish. Brilliant with seafood.

**Marco Tinessa**  
**Falanghina**

Rubice Bianco is a 100% Falanghina from two high-altitude Campania sites: Bonea (600 m, ~50-year-old vines) and Montesarchio (300 m, ~90-year-old vines). Fermentation is spontaneous, with 2 days of skin contact, then 7 months' aging in stainless steel. Fresh yet textured, it shines as an aperitif.

Marco Tinessa's Ognostro White is a striking expression of Campania Fiano, matured for 18 months in concrete and amphora. Vallissassoli 33/33/33 comes from a single one-hectare vineyard trained in the traditional Avellinese pergola system, where Fiano, Greco, and Coda di Volpe grow side by side. Co-fermented in equal parts, they create a harmonious, vibrant white wine that captures the authentic soul of Irpinia.

**Muscat - Parellada**

Artesano Vintners "Pardalet" is a lightly macerated Catalan white blending Muscat with Parellada. Organic vines on clay-gypsum, limestone-rich soils at 300 m. Hand-harvested, spontaneous ferment in steel with brief skin contact, aged in steel, unfiltered, no additives or SO<sub>2</sub>. Herbaceous, saline, long.

Exotic and expressive, this Gewurztraminer from Pfalz (Dien Weinmacher) shines with lychee, rose petals and ripe peach. Aromatic and silky on the palate, it offers gentle spice, tropical fruit and a hint of sweetness, finishing long, floral and refreshing.

Named for the French phrase meaning "afloat" or "on the water," À Flot evokes the breezy Mediterranean coast. This organic rosé blends Grenache, Cinsault, and Syrah into a crisp, saline wine with notes of wild berries and citrus—refreshing, elegant, and made for seaside moments.
